**1. Biblical \_\_\_\_\_ Is Past, Present, and Future.**

*For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)*

*For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (1 Corinthians 1:18)*

*Who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. (1 Peter 1:5)*

**2. Salvation Past Freed Me from the \_\_\_\_\_ of Sin.**

*For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)*

*The wages of sin is death... (Romans 6:23)*

*"...I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin...So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." (John 8:34,36)*

**3. Salvation Present Frees Me from the \_\_\_\_\_ of Sin.**

*...continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling. (Philippians 2:12)*

*Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)*

*Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly--mere infants in Christ. I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men? (1 Corinthians 3:1-3)*

*Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! (2 Corinthians 5:17)*

*Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)*

*...when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. (1 John 3:2)*

*Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. (Romans 10:13)*
